To commemorate and respect the national language and to imbibe interest for Hindi language in students, BKM Science College in association with Social organization Upvan observed 14th September 2016 as Hindi Divas and organized inter college Elocution competition at college campus. The need to preserve Hindi as a language was highlighted to the students and they performed a short Hindi skit in Hindi. Clippings from Hindi newspaper and Articles of popular Hindi Writer was presented by the students.

On this occasion President of 'Upvan' Arunbhai Minocha gave information that in 1918 when Mahatma Gandhi, widely regarded as the Father of the Nation, had attended a conference on Hindi literature and asked Hindi to be made the national language of India. He had even gone ahead and called it the language of everyone. It was on 14th September 1949 that Hindi, along with English, was accepted as the official language of India by the Constituent Assembly. It was from 1953 onwards that Hindi Diwas was celebrated on 14th September in order to promote the national language. In addition the manager of Bank of Baroda Mr. Vipilbhai has also shred his views and talked about how the Hindi language has come to an existence.

The Principal Dr. Vikas Desai emphasized the value of Hindi as a National language which has a rich cultural tradition. He also highlighted the importance of Hindi language which is also the first language spoken by more than 250 million Indians. The contribution of Mahadevi Varma, Harivandhrai Bachchan and other such stalwarts to Hindi literature was also emphasized.

Vice Principal Dr.T.G.Gohil told On September 14, 1949, which marked the 50th birthday of Hindi scholar and stalwart Beohar Rajendra Simha, his hard work paid off and Hindi was adopted as the official language of the country. Stalwarts like Beohar Rajendra Simha, Hazari Prasad Dwivedi, Kaka Kalelkar, Maithili Sharan Gupt and Seth Govind Das lobbied hard in favour of Hindi to be made the official language of India.

The students have participated enthusiastically and performed well in the competition and that shows their inherit skills and capabilities. Moreover they were very eloquent and presented themselves in an effective way. At the end of the competition the winners were awarded with the prizes and the participants were given certificates. Shri.A.K.Desai and Shri.Shrikant kanojia rendered their service as a judges of the Competition.
